Life members should also complete and return the Ireland Team declaration form on or before 31st January annually.

All Ireland Team members must be present for the Team photographs, must attend the Home Countries International Tournament Banquet and must comply with the stated dress code. Any Team member who fails to do so without justifiable reason will not be eligible for Ireland Team selection in the following year.

All Ireland Team members must wear the ICPSA shooting vest. Failure to comply with this directive will result in non-participation at the event in question.

Applications for same should be made in sufficient time as to be in force at the time of any visit and at present this process takes approx. one month.
