* Any individual or club member who recruits a new or a lapsed member who has not been a member for more than three years will receive a “bounty” of €25. This €25 is receivable for each and every new/lapsed member recruited and is allowable against the individual/club membership payment in the following year up to the maximum of the membership fee for that year and affords all members the opportunity to further reduce the cost of participating in our sport. It should be noted however that this €25 is payable to whoever proposes the new/lapsed member on the application form at the time of the application for membership.

** Where a shooter is a member of more than one ICTSC affiliated clay target shooting Association they must indicate this on the application form detailing their alternative membership number(s). If a member as a result of multiple memberships has more than one classification they must enter in the highest class they hold in that discipline and failure to do so will be classed as cheating.

*** The Ireland Team declaration element of this form has been revised to allow only for the declaration of veteran status. Where someone has previously been a veteran they will remain so and if no declaration is made, they will be classed as seniors even if they qualify as veterans.

**** In 2011 all ICPSA members may enter an end of year draw for a Life Membership at a cost of €10 per entry. Members may enter more than once in order to increase the opportunity to win.

Ireland Team members must be present for the Team photographs, attend the post Tournament Banquet and must comply with the stated dress code. Any Team member who fails to do so without justifiable reason may not be eligible for Ireland Team selection in the following year. Team members must wear the stipulated shooting vest. Failure to comply with this directive may result in non-participation at the event in question. All Team members are also responsible for ensuring that they have the necessary visitor’s shotgun permits.

ICPSA members resident in the North of Ireland are reminded that a current visitor’s firearms permit is required from An Garda Siochana when participating in the Republic of Ireland. Applications forms for same are available as a download on www.icpsa.ie

All ICPSA members resident in the Republic of Ireland are reminded that a current visitor’s firearms permit is required from the PSNI when participating in the North of Ireland. All details of this process, the requirements and an application form can be found at www.psni.police.uk and UK visitor’s shotgun permits may be applied for on line through the CPSA at www.cpsa.co.uk or through the ICPSA. Applications for same should be made in sufficient time as to be in force at the time of any visit and at present this process takes approx. one month. ICPSA members who apply for a UK visitors permit through the ICPSA must state if they have any convictions, including for drink driving.
